This form is required ONLY for students in VARSITY CHORALE and CHAMBER (Spiritus Lupus).

Timberview Choir Varsity Agreement 2025-2026

Membership in the varsity choirs and chamber at the Timberview Choral Department requires a higher level of commitment than the other choral ensembles. Varsity choir members are expected to be exemplary students both in choir and in all their endeavors at Timberview HS. Participation in the varsity level choirs should be considered a privilege and not a right. Consistent in-class discipline problems, multiple placements in in-school suspension, BIC, discipline referrals for fighting, substance abuse, and/or bringing weapons on campus, will result in a loss of privileges in the choral program to include movement into a different ensemble, loss of traveling privileges, suspension from performances, or removal from the choral program at the director's discretion.

As a member of a varsity ensemble, you will be expected to:

- Always maintain academic eligibility (2 instances of ineligibility will result in dismissal from the ensemble, into a lower or non-competing group).
- Maintain an exemplary discipline record.
- Attend all performances and required after-school rehearsals. We will try to accommodate
 most of our students with our rehearsal schedule, but there will always be conflicts that
 may need to be worked out.
- Serve as a leader both musically and personally in the choir program.
- Prepare and audition for the first round of All-State Auditions.
- Chamber: Prepare a solo to perform for the Solo & Ensemble competition or at recital.
- Participate in all choir events-Concerts, Socials, Fundraising, etc.
- Actively seek to improve your vocal ability and musicianship skills.
- Must attempt level up sight-reading every six-weeks regardless of level. ALL students need to successfully level up every semester.
- Students who do not reach Level 3 by December 2025 will have an evaluation of their progress in varsity; students who do not reach Level 5 by May 2026 will have to reaudition for the ensemble.
- Chamber students are subject to moving to Varsity Chorale only should they not pass Round 1 based on their preparation.

Failure to meet any of these requirements will result in the student receiving a probation notice and will result in loss of membership in the group and movement to a non-varsity choir if the problem is not resolved within a given period. This will cause a change in the student's class schedule at the earliest possible time so that they may be placed in a more appropriate ensemble.
